TOPIC: Rocks, fossils and soils

This term our topic is "Dinosaur". In **Science**, we will be learning all about **rocks and soils**. We will be taking part in some investigations! We will also be learning all about **fossils** and how they are made. In **English**, we will be reading 'Dinosaur Cove' books and learning to write our descriptions of a settings using interesting vocabulary, joining words and sentence starters.

Every week you must also:

- Read your reading book at least 4 times.
- Practice your 2, 3, 4, 5, 8 and 10 times tables and opposite division facts.
- Practice your spellings given to you.
- Complete your maths homework.

Go on a rocks and fossil hunt – take pictures

Write a diary about being a fossil hunter

Create a comic strip of a fossil hunter

Make a fossil – you can use clay, playdough or salt dough

Write instructions for how to make a fossil

Make a video of how to make a fossil as if you were a Youtuber.

Draw and label a picture of your favourite dinosaur

Make a 3D model

Research facts about your dinosaur

Task completed

Draw a treasure map to find dinosaurs and write instructions

Can you use different 'bossy verbs' to write directions for your map

Use time connectives to direct somebody

Research facts about dinosaur e.g. where they lived. Create a mind map or poster.

Find out what happened to the dinosaurs

Which dinosaur is your favourite and why

Task completed

Write a story about finding a fossil

Remember to use exciting adjectives (describing words).

Can you include some adverbs? (-ly words like happily, grumpily, sadly.)

Investigate what rocks there are around your home.

Write a report of what rocks you have found and what it is used for.

Include a 'How it's made' section in your report explaining how your item is made from rocks

Maths – 5 6 2

How many 3 digit numbers can you make? Draw the base 10 and write the number in words

Can you partition them in more than one way e.g. $562 = 500 + 60 + 2$ or $562 = 400 + 160 + 2$

Write a place value question for somebody else and write an explanation on how to work it out. Explain what the answer is and why.
